#### **DESCRIPTION**

The PS7802B-1A is a low output capacitance solid state relay containing a GaAs LED on the light emitting side (input side) and MOS FETs on the output side.

An ultra small flat-lead package has been provided which realizes a reduction in mounting area of about 50% compared with the PS72xx series.


It is suitable for high-frequency signal control, due to its low  $C \times R$  (6.3 pF •  $\Omega$ ), low output capacitance, and low off-state leakage current.






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# PACKAGE DIMENSIONS (UNIT: mm)




# \*1 Test Circuit for Switching Time




\*2 The turn-on time and turn-off time are specified as input-pulse width  $\geq$  1.0 ms.


