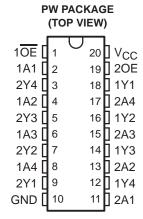

description/ordering information

This octal buffer/driver is designed specifically for low-voltage (3.3-V) V_{CC} operation, with the capability to provide a TTL interface to a 5-V system environment.

The SN74LVTH241 is organized as two 4-bit line drivers with separate output-enable ($1\overline{OE}$, 2OE) inputs. When $1\overline{OE}$ is low or 2OE is high, the device passes noninverted data from the A inputs to the Y outputs. When $1\overline{OE}$ is high or 2OE is low, the outputs are in the high-impedance state.

Active bus-hold circuitry holds unused or undriven inputs at a valid logic state. Use of pullup or pulldown resistors with the bus-hold circuitry is not recommended.

When V_{CC} is between 0 and 1.5 V, the device is in the high-impedance state during power up or power down. However, to ensure the high-impedance state above 1.5 V, \overline{OE} should be tied to V_{CC} through a pullup resistor and OE should be tied to GND through a pulldown resistor; the minimum value of the resistor is determined by the current-sinking/current-sourcing capability of the driver.

This device is fully specified for hot-insertion applications using I_{off} and power-up 3-state. The I_{off} circuitry disables the outputs, preventing damaging current backflow through the device when it is powered down. The power-up 3-state circuitry places the outputs in the high-impedance state during power up and power down, which prevents driver conflict.

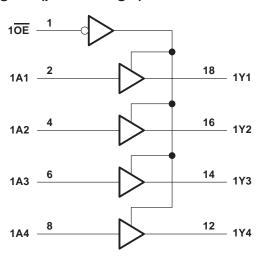


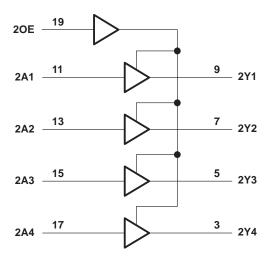

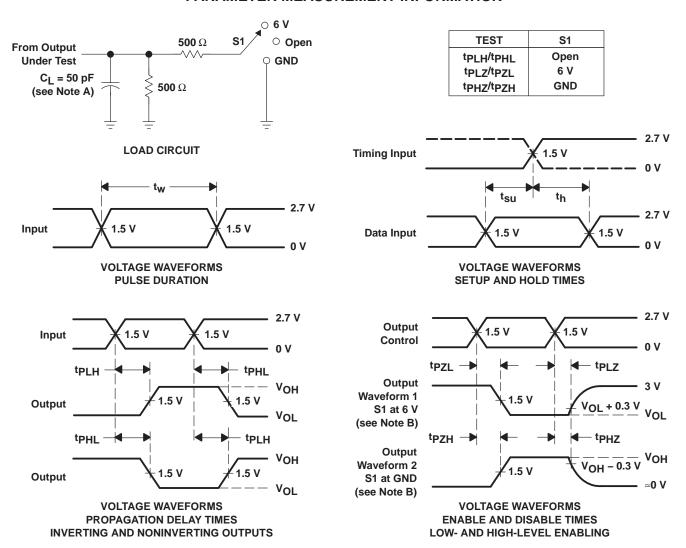
